

HOW MUCH DO THINGS COST IN PHI PHI ISLANDS?

HOTEL PRICES AVERAGE COST: \$30USD

The average price of a guesthouse room for two, with air-conditioning is around \$30 per night. This is the most common accommodation type on the island. Dorm rooms can be as low as \$8 a night. While top hotels in the town charge on average \$80 per night.





TRANSPORT PRICES AVERAGE COST: \$0USD

Getting around Phi Phi Island is cheap. In fact, it's free. There is no public transport, no taxis or vehicles on the island. Taxi boats cost about \$10 to hop to another beach, but they are not essential. You can walk anywhere you want to go.

ACTIVITY PRICES AVERAGE COST: \$50USD

For a quality island hopping tour around Phi Phi Islands you should expect to pay about \$50. This is something you don't want to cheap out on. Cheaper tours can cost \$20. But you'll will need to pay an extra charge at national parks and will share a boat with 30+ other people.





FOOD PRICES AVERAGE COST: \$2USD

Western foods like pizzas, pasta or burger and chips are widely available on Koh Phi Phi. But you'll pay close to \$10 a meal. Stick to the Thai food and in most restaurants you can enjoy a full meal for less than \$2. Food prices are even cheaper at the markets. Where you can get a (delicious) Thai Chicken Red Curry with rice and a drink for \$1.50!

DRINK PRICES AVERAGE COST: \$2USD

It's cheap to drink in Phi Islands. Beers from 7-11 supermarkets cost about \$1 or about \$2 in a bar. Cocktails are in the same price range. But the Phi Phi special is a party bucket filled with booze. Buckets are sold as cheap as \$3 and contain 14 standard spirit mesures!
